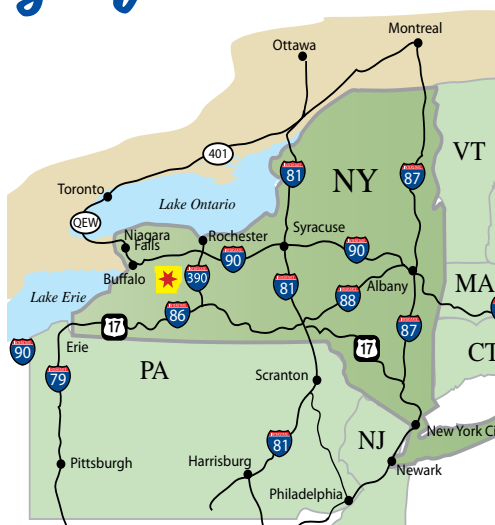

Letchworth State Park

Surround yourself in nature at the **#1 State Park in the USA** and the **#1 Attraction in New York State**. Letchworth State Park, is a natural wonderland featuring 14,350 acres and 66 miles of gorgeous hiking, biking, horse and cross-country skiing trails.

Enjoy the Genesee River Gorge which splits the park in two and can be up to 600 feet deep. These incredible rock formations frame three major waterfalls, including the 110-foot drop of the Middle Falls.

Soar over Letchworth State Park in a hot air balloon and experience the 600 foot river gorge walls up close with **Balloons Over Letchworth**. Learn more on page 37.

Take a free guided tour of the **Mount Morris Dam & Visitor Center** including many scenic overlooks and a 5,400 square foot visitor center filled with information and interactive exhibits.

Take a selfie at the **Genesee Arch Bridge** spanning the Genesee River gorge over the Upper Falls. The 483 foot bridge sits above the falls and is a popular location to spot bald eagles.

The Park offers rustic to luxury accommodations ranging from campsites, cabins, cottages, lodges and the historic **Glen Iris Inn**, the original home of Willam Pryor Letchworth.

The Glen Iris Inn offers breakfast, lunch and dinner overlooking the majesty of the Middle Falls and the Genesee River Gorge.

Did you know...the Legacy of William Pryor Letchworth



Letchworth State Park exists today due to the generosity of one man, William Pryor Letchworth, a businessman from Buffalo NY. He was a visionary, leader, and a Quaker committed to social justice.

Over time, he purchased 1,000 acres near the Upper and Middle Falls, including the building that became his home. He named his estate Glen Iris.

To preserve this land for all to enjoy, he offered it to the State of New York in 1907. When he died in 1910, his land transferred to the state. Since that time, Letchworth State Park has grown to 14,350 acres, stretching 17 miles along the Genesee River.

William Pryor Letchworth Museum



The Museum features displays including a gigantic mastodon skull, stories of Native American culture, early pioneer history, the three railroad bridges that have stood above the Upper Falls, and accounts of the park's development including work done by the Depression Era Civilian Conservation Corps.

The Council Grounds, including Mary Jemison

Mr. Letchworth was fascinated by the story of Mary Jemison, a pioneer girl who was captured during the French and Indian War, adopted by the Seneca, and eventually settled on 18,000 acres in the Genesee Valley. Mr. Letchworth erected a bronze statue of her at the Council Grounds. This area also displays an authentic Seneca Council House, a cabin once owned by Mary's daughter Nancy, and a rustic sitting pavilion.

In 2024, New York's State Parks and Historic Sites will celebrate its Centennial, commemorating the 100th anniversary of the founding of the NYS parks and sites system. This system was built for everyone, and continues to serve as an acknowledgment that public access to open space and recreational assets is a right, and not a privilege, afforded to all New Yorkers.

You've helped forge the last one hundred years of recreation and stewardship – and will help ignite one hundred years ahead.

The Autism Nature Trail

A Nature Trail for all at Letchworth State Park



The state park voted #1 in the country by online fans is home to a first-of-its-kind experience in nature designed for visitors with autism and other developmental differences.

The **Autism Nature Trail** (The ANT) is the first Trail to be built for the neurodiverse population, rather than simply modifying something that was preexisting to fit the needs of neurodiverse individuals.

The ANT at Letchworth State Park offers visitors a one-mile ADA-compliant hike through a stunning pine forest, including 8 stations with activities which support and encourage sensory perception and

integration, while also providing enjoyment for persons of all abilities and ages.

The stations engage each individual's auditory, visual, olfactory, tactile, vestibular and proprioceptive processing, using nature and natural materials as the tools for skill-building. Each station was built with sensory processing in mind. Several stations along the Trail offer an "Alone Zone" where a hiker can choose to do the same activity in their own space or choose to skip the activity altogether.

Visitors are welcome for self-guided hikes anytime the park is open, and programming with trained staff from Camp Puzzle Peace is also available at scheduled times.

Camp Puzzle Peace offers weekend programming from May thru October. They also provide families with resources to use to be successful on the Trail such as social stories, visual schedules, and 'first-then' boards.

The Autism Nature Trail is located halfway up the sidewalk from the parking lot adjacent to the Humphrey Nature Center accessed easily through the Castile Entrance to Letchworth State Park.





The ANT begins and ends at the same location—a timber frame structure called the Trailhead Pavilion on the way in and the Celebration Station on the way out.

Nature Abounds

Love the outdoors by hiking **Beaver Meadow Audubon Center**, a 350-acre nature preserve in North Java, offering over eight miles of marked trails for hiking, snowshoeing and cross-country skiing, a visitor center, indoor exhibits, gift shop, nature art exhibits, animal exhibits and wildlife observation windows.

The Nature Center is open six days a week and has a staff of naturalists

that provide educational support and outreach programs.

Get wild in **Carlton Hill Multiple Use Area**, outside the Village of Wyoming. This 2,500-acre area has an array of trails crossing sprawling hardwoods, towering pines, open fields, babbling brooks and more. It's a birder's paradise and a hidden gem for mountain bikers!

Of course, everyone loves exploring **Letchworth State Park** – with over 66 miles of trails – we've included the park's official trail map on page 38 & 39 of this guide to help you select the perfect location for your adventure!

Fishing & Boating

Angling for an adventure? Wyoming County's streams & lakes are filled with a variety of trout, bass, pike, perch and walleye. Rent an AirBnB on the shores of beautiful Silver

Lake and fish at **Silver Lake State Park**. You can rent a party boat from **Silver Lake Marine** or a pedal boat from **Paddle.Sail.Smile** and cast a line in style. With over 7 miles of shoreline and a maximum depth of 37 feet, Silver Lake is a recreational destination for fishing, boating, swimming and the home of the famous Silver Lake Sea Serpent!

Biking & Hiking

Get out and bike rolling hills & spectacular countryside! Start at **Letchworth State Park**, where they have over 40-miles of mountain bike trails ranging from easy to challenging. Outside the park, State Route 19 is a 109-mile north-south, on-road bike path that runs from the Town of Pike to the Town Middlebury in Wyoming County.

The **Genesee Valley Greenway** is a 90-mile hiking & biking rails-to-trail that passes through five counties from the Village of Cuba to Downtown Rochester. Bask in the beauty of the Genesee River and

get up close and personal with bald eagles, hawks & more. Interpretive signage is provided along the trail at key locations giving info about the history, flora & fauna of the region.

Take a leisurely ride on your bike or motorcycle and enjoy the fall scenery in Wyoming County – be sure to visit the **Cannon Covered Bridge** – a newly constructed all-wood covered bridge hidden in the majestic backroads of Cowlesville, in the Town of Bennington.

Winter Fun

When the snow flies: rent cross-country skis at **Byrncliff Golf Resort**

Many are located next to great local restaurants where you can stop in, enjoy a burger and a craft beer!

Wyoming County's Historic Underground Railroad Connections

HISTORY

Founded in 1841, Wyoming County has a unique and fascinating story. With historic homes and monuments, the railroad and salt industry, and Native American history, we are proud of our tradition and contribution to the American experience.



Wyoming County also played a vital role in the Underground Railroad, an escape route that took fugitive slaves from points south, through Western New York and into Canada by way of Buffalo. There were several locations that served as "stations" along the way where escaped slaves could

hide from search parties, replenish their food and clothing, and receive directions and encouragement from sympathizers helping the fugitive slaves gain their precious freedom. Wyoming County is proud to have played an important part in helping to free all those brave souls who passed through the area on their way to "the promised land," and recognizes all those who helped the former slaves realize the dream of living as free men and women.

Warsaw, the County seat, is home to multiple Underground Railroad locations and it's residents were early leaders in the abolitionist movement. The Augustus Frank House, located near the monument on Main Street, and the Seth Gates House (now the Warsaw Historical Society) were homes to US Representatives who fought aggressively to abolish slavery. In addition to the Underground Railroad information, the Warsaw Historical Society

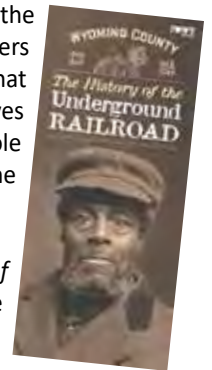
also offers historical and ghost walks around the Village of Warsaw, which includes a stop at the Augustus Frank House.

It is not well-known that America's first anti-slavery political party was organized in Wyoming County at the Warsaw Presbyterian Church in 1839. Wyoming County grew to have the second largest number of conductors and station masters in New York State, after Monroe County. The Fugitive Slave Act of 1850 made it illegal to harbor or help fugitive slaves. For that reason, the events of the Underground Railroad were shrouded in secrecy.



Though many of the buildings that were involved in the railroad no longer stand, there is sufficient evidence from the records of town historians, private family letters and known publications to document the part that Wyoming County played in helping escaped slaves find freedom.
