

Letchworth State Park

EXPLORE THE GRAND CANYON OF THE EAST

Surround yourself in nature at the #1 State Park in the USA and the #1 Attraction in New York State. Letchworth State Park, is a natural wonderland featuring 14,350 acres and 66 miles of gorgeous hiking, biking, horse and cross-country skiing trails.

Enjoy the Genesee River Gorge which splits the park in two and can be up to 600 feet deep. These incredible rock formations frame three major waterfalls, including the 110-foot drop of the Middle Falls.

Tame the whitewater of the Genesee River as you raft through the "Grand Canyon of the East" with Adventure Calls Outfitters.

Soar over Letchworth State Park in a hot air balloon and experience the 600 foot river gorge walls up close with Balloons Over Letchworth.

Take a free guided tour of the Mount Morris Dam & Visitor Center including many scenic overlooks and a 5,400 square foot visitor center filled with information and interactive exhibits.

Take a selfie at the Genesee Arch Bridge spanning the Genesee River gorge over the Upper Falls. The 483 foot bridge sits above the falls and is a popular location to spot bald eagles.

The Park offers rustic to luxury accommodations ranging from campsites, cabins, cottages, lodges and the historic Glen Iris Inn.

The Glen Iris Inn offers breakfast, lunch and dinner overlooking the majesty of the Middle Falls and the Genesee River Gorge.

The Autism Nature Trail

A Nature Trail for all at Letchworth State Park



The state park voted #1 in the country by online fans is home to a first-of-its-kind experience in nature designed for visitors with autism and other developmental differences.

The **Autism Nature Trail** (The ANT) is the first Trail to be built for the neurodiverse population, rather than simply modifying something that was preexisting to fit the needs of neurodiverse individuals.

The ANT at Letchworth State Park offers visitors a one-mile ADA-compliant hike through a stunning pine forest, including 8 stations with activities which support and encourage sensory perception and

integration, while also providing enjoyment for persons of all abilities and ages.

The stations engage each individual's auditory, visual, olfactory, tactile, vestibular and proprioceptive processing, using nature and natural materials as the tools for skill-building. Each station was built with sensory processing in mind- several stations along the Trail offer an "Alone Zone" where a hiker can choose to do the same activity in their own space or choose to skip the activity altogether.

Visitors are welcome for self-guided hikes anytime the park is open, and programming with trained staff from Camp Puzzle Peace is also available at scheduled times.


Camp Puzzle Peace offers programming from May thru October. They also provide families with resources to use to be successful on the Trail such as social stories, visual schedules, and 'first-then' boards.

The Autism Nature Trail is located halfway up the sidewalk from the parking lot adjacent to the Humphrey Nature Center accessed easily through the Castile Entrance to Letchworth State Park.

Hiking

ove the outdoors by hiking Beaver
Meadow Audubon Center, a 350acre nature preserve in North Java,
offering over eight miles of marked
trails for hiking, snowshoeing
and cross-country skiing, a visitor
center, indoor exhibits, gift shop,
nature art exhibits, animal exhibits
and wildlife observation windows.

Their Nature Center is open six days a week and has a staff of naturalists

that provide educational support and outreach programs.

Get wild in Carlton Hill Multiple Use Area, outside the Village of Wyoming. This 2,500-acre area has an array of trails crossing sprawling hardwoods, towering pines, open fields, babbling brooks and more. It's a birder's paradise and a hidden gem for mountain bikers!

Of course, everyone loves exploring **Letchworth State Park** – with over 66 miles of trails – we've included the park's official trail map on page 42 & 43 of this guide to help you select the perfect location for your adventure!

Fishing & Boating

Angling for an adventure? Wyoming County's streams & lakes are filled with a variety of trout, bass, pike, perch and walleye. Rent an AirBnB on the shores of beautiful Silver

Lake and fish at Silver Lake State Park. You can rent a party boat from Silver Lake Marine or a pedal boat from Paddle.Sail.Smile and cast a line in style. With over 7 miles of shoreline and a maximum depth of 37 feet, Silver Lake is a recreational destination for fishing, boating, swimming and the home of the famous Silver Lake Sea Serpent!

BIKING AT LETCHWORTH STATE PARK

Biking

Get out and bike rolling hills & spectacular countryside! Start at Letchworth State Park, where they have over 40-miles of mountain bike trails ranging from easy to challenging. Outside the park, State Route 19 is a 109-mile northsouth, on-road bike path that runs from the Town of Pike to the Town Middlebury in Wyoming County.

The Genesee Valley Greenway is a 90-mile hiking & biking railsto-trail that passes through five counties from the Village of Cuba to Downtown Rochester. Bask in the beauty of the Genesee River and get up close and personal with bald eagles, hawks & more. Interpretive signage is provided along the trail at key locations giving info about the history, flora & fauna of the region.

Take a leisurely ride on your bike or motorcycle and enjoy the fall scenery in Wyoming County - be sure to visit the Cannon Covered Bridge - a newly constructed allwood covered bridge hidden in the majestic backroads of Cowlesville, in the Town of Bennington.

When the snow flies: rent crosscountry skis at **Byrncliff Golf Resort**

& Banquets and hit their groomed trails, rent snowshoes at Beaver Meadow Audubon, go tubing at Letchworth next to the **Humphrey** Nature Center while warming up next to the fire at Trailside Lodge. Snowmobilers will love traveling through scenic wooded trails, open fields and rolling hills on over 250 miles of groomed trails. Many are located next to great local restaurants where you can stop in, enjoy a burger and a craft beer!


Let's run down some exciting hot spots, filled with excitement and adventure:

THE LEGEND OF THE SILVER LAKE **SEA SERPENT**

HISTORY



n the moonlit night of July 13, 1855, four men and two boys were fishing in a boat on Silver Lake. Their dock growing dimmer as they paddled into the darkness of the warm, breezy night.

A quiet night of fishing and enjoying the pleasant summer

weather was all that any of those in the small boat were planning on for their evening's entertainment. After several hours of fishing, the men grew tired and began to paddle their boat back to the dock. The hour had grown late, and the sun was long since set behind the horizon.

As they began to row the boat in, each passenger watched as a nearby floating log began to move, dipping in and out of the water. Then without notice, a horrid beast leapt from the water, showing itself in all its glory before splashing back into the murky water and disappearing. The fishermen were struck with terror, and frantically rushed back to shore to alert the local authorities. While their story sounded impossible, they had just confronted a massive, scaly, dinosaur like creature, borne from the depths of Silver Lake. The legend of the Silver Lake Sea Serpent was born.

But, the secret origins of the Serpent started two years early. Business on Silver Lake had been painfully slow in the early summer of 1855. Mr. A. B. Walker had an idea about how to change all of that. He owned the Walker Hotel, and to run his hotel, he desperately needed customers. Night after night in an old tannery along the Silver Lake Outlet, Walker and a few friends met and worked together to make his deviously creative idea a reality. Slowly, foot by foot, a sea serpent grew out of a coiled wire, waterproof canvas, paint and the excited energy of these few men.

Weeks later, on July 13th, Walker and friends saw a boatload of fishermen rowing out into the moonlit night. They decided it was the time to reveal their new creation. From a shanty on the west shore, the conspirators operated the bellows which filled their sunken monster with air (which came through a hose that ran through a gas pipe sunk in the lake). As the head rose gracefully to a height of about eight feet and various other parts rose out of the water to equal heights, the fishermen received the fright of their lives, while Walker and his friends' received results far beyond their wildest dreams!

It didn't take long for word to spread about the hideous serpent. The hotels in Silver Lake and Perry were filled to capacity as people poured into the area from across the country to see the Silver Lake Serpent! They came by train, stage, buggy and horseback. Several expeditions were launched, including a whale-man with a harpoon, a crazed society of men armed with guns, and even companies who spent thousands on employees bent on capturing the creature.

Sadly, nothing was ever found until 1857, a fire broke out at the Walker Hotel. Fireman rushed to the scene to put out the



blaze. When they worked their way into the attic, they came upon a strange sight. Within the burned wreckage of the hotel, there sat the great sea serpent wire frame and remnants of its scaly green mesh. After the fire, Mr. Walker confessed he had created the monster to attract visitors to town, and fill up his hotel. It's said that Mr. Walker was inspired to build his sea serpent, based on a Seneca Nation story about a monster that once inhabited the waters of Silver Lake.

The Seneca's believed that any unnecessary or unnatural noise over the water could cause a slug like creature to rise up and pull anyone to their doom. As such, great care was taken to maintain silence over and near the water. One day however, a severe lightning storm came and a bolt of lightning struck the lake casting the terrible monster upon the shore, where some of the brave warriors succeeded in killing it with bows and arrows. From that time on, anyone could talk, yell or make any noise they care to, either on the shore or on the lake.





To this day, the locals of Silver Lake and Perry celebrate the story with boat parades and festivals. The Legend of the Silver Lake Sea Serpent Lives On!

While A.B. Walker's creation no longer exists, there are many ways you can have your very own close encounter with the Silver Lake Sea Serpent - here are a few great ideas:




